Memorial Considerations

• Cemetery

Be cautious in choosing your memorial as many cemeteries have regulations regarding the type and size of monuments allowable.

• Style of Monument

- Upright - A wide variety of standard and custom shapes
- Slant Upright - Generally lower in height, the face is cut on an angle.
- Slope Marker - Cut on a bevel, thicker at the back, usually on a base.
- Flat Marker - Lies flat in the ground, usually for one name and little design.
- Cremation Internment - Ashes can be interred inside your personal granite memorial

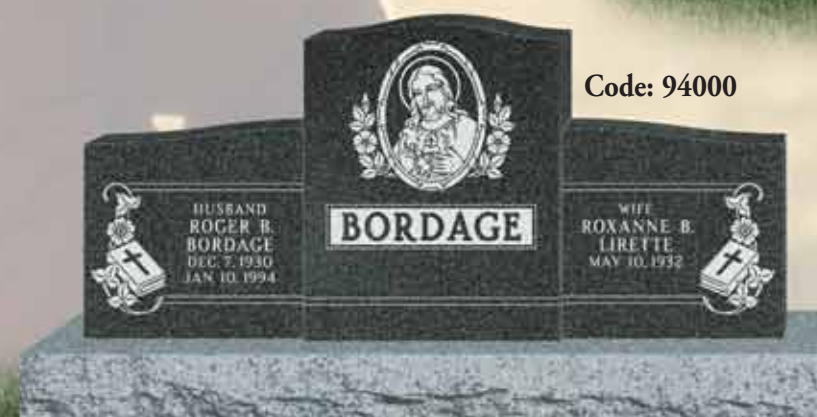

Memorial Considerations (cont'd)

• *Design*

There are many variables to a design, all of which together make your memorial unique.

Here are a few:

- Lettering style
- Symbolism of crests and design components
- Scenes that are sandblasted, etched and can be done in great detail
- Epitaph or verse
- Inscription, including significant information such as the maiden name, wedding date, children's names
- Accessories, such as vases, statues, portraits or similar attachments.
